



## **TICKET TERMS AND CONDITIONS (“Terms”)**

Your ticket is a revocable license, which may be withdrawn, and admission refused anytime. Portland Timbers/Portland Thorns, National Women’s Soccer League, and Major League Soccer, and their affiliates together (“Management”) reserve the right to eject any ticket holder. By using your ticket, you are deemed to have agreed on behalf of yourself and minors accompanying you (together, “You”) to these terms and conditions and the Providence Park Stadium Guide & FAQ.

You agree not to create, transmit, display, distribute, exploit or sell (or aid in such activity) any photographs, images, videos, livestreams, audio or other form of display or public performance or reproduction of any portion of the ticketed event (“Works”). You are deemed to have signed your ticket and granted Management, an exclusive worldwide, irrevocable, perpetual, sub-licensable, royalty-free license to all rights associated with any Works.

You grant permission to Management and their sponsors, licensees, advertisers, broadcasters, designers and agents to use, publish, edit, and alter your image, likeness, voice, actions and statements in any medium including, without limitation, any audio, video, film, photographs, social media, exhibition, publication or reproduction of the event for any purpose without further authorization or compensation and waive all claims and potential claims relating to such use unless prohibited by law.

Management may change the date or time of the event, which change will not entitle you to a refund. YOU VOLUNTARILY ASSUME ALL RISKS, HAZARDS AND DANGERS arising from or relating in any way to the event. THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE REMEDY if admission is refused or revoked, is a refund of up to the ticket price set by Management (the “Face Value”), unless otherwise provided below. If the event is cancelled, Management, at its option, may offer you a ticket to a rescheduled or comparable event within 12 months of the event date or a refund up to the Face Value of the ticket, as your sole and exclusive remedy.

IN NO EVENT WILL MANAGEMENT BE LIABLE FOR ANY SPECIAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, INCIDENTAL, INDIRECT OR EXEMPLARY DAMAGES OF ANY KIND, OR ANY DAMAGES BEYOND THE FACE VALUE OF THE TICKET. ANY DISPUTE OR CLAIM RELATED TO, OR ARISING FROM, YOUR TICKET WILL BE RESOLVED BY MANDATORY, CONFIDENTIAL, FINAL, AND BINDING ARBITRATION. YOU AND MANAGEMENT EACH AGREE THAT ALL DISPUTES WILL BE ARBITRATED ON AN INDIVIDUAL BASIS AND EACH WAIVES ANY RIGHT TO LITIGATE IN COURT OR ARBITRATE ANY CLAIM AS A CLASS ACTION, REPRESENTATIVE ACTION, OR CLASS ARBITRATION. IF YOU DO NOT CONSENT TO THIS CLAUSE (OR ANY OTHER OF THESE TERMS), YOU MUST LEAVE OR NOT ENTER THE STADIUM. THIS CLAUSE IS GOVERNED BY THE FEDERAL ARBITRATION ACT.
